This position is critical to the collaborations between psychiatry and other specialties (ex. Transplant, Neurology, Neurosurgery, General Internal Medicine, Oncology, Sleep Medicine, Addictions) in the clinical diagnosis and treatment of patient with cognitive impairments that can be due to medical and/or psychiatrist issues.

Responsibilities include performing evaluations and neuropsychological testing services. Qualified candidates will have their PhD in clinical psychology/clinical neuropsychology, completed an APA approved clinical internship with a neuropsychology emphasis, have at least two years of supervised postdoctoral training in clinical neuropsychology, and will be licensed or license eligible in the State of Illinois.
